Did you know?

- Lead was used in paint on homes built before 1978
- Dust, mold and strong odors (like paint) can trigger asthma
- Lead can be found on your windows, doors, walls and floors
- Children under 6 are at higher risk of being poisoned by exposure to lead

"We Believe in a Healthy Home" can offer

- Preliminary lead testing to determine if lead is present on painted surfaces
- Lead Inspection/Risk Assessment of your home
- Lead Remediation and Abatement of lead hazards
- Education on how to keep your home and family safe from lead and asthma triggers
- Referrals to medical provider

You must live in a one or two unit residential home in Essex County built before 1978. The property must be structurally sound and current on real estate taxes, water and sewer.

To qualify for Lead-Safe Home Remediation: Your household income must be within the low-to-moderate income limits listed below:

ANNUAL INCOME LIMITS BY HOUSEHOLD SIZE FOR LEAD-SAFE HOME REMEDIATION:

- 1 person: \$47,600
- 2 people: \$54,400
- 3 people: \$61,200
- 4 people: \$68,000
