


### ABOUT US

**La Casa de Don Pedro, Inc. (LCDP)** was founded in 1972 by a group of local activists seeking to establish educational and charitable programs to meet the needs of Newark's Puerto Rican community.

Named in honor of **Don Pedro Albizu Campos**, LCDP has since evolved to become the largest Latinx-led organization in the state of New Jersey, serving 50,000 Newark and Essex County residents annually under three central pillars: **Early Childhood** (Prenatal, Early Head Start, Head Start, and Pre-K); **Healthy Homes** (Low Income Heating and Energy Assistance Program [LIHEAP], Weatherization, Lead Remediation/Abatement); and **Community Empowerment** (Women & Family Center, Immigration, Workforce Readiness, Youth Enrichment, Housing & Home Ownership Support, and Community Organizing).






